Elizabeth Hodgson was baptised 24th November, 1861 at Temple, Bristol, Gloucestershire. Her sister Maria Hodgson was baptised the same day. Parents William Bartlett (Potter) and Maria, his wife.

Elizabeth Hodgson's father and mother were William Hodgson born 1825 in Bristol, Gloucestershire and Maria Bull born 1834 in Pill, Somerset

Parents Marriage

William and Maria Hodgson married at parish church St James, Bristol on 09 Mar 1856. Both sign their names on the marriage certificate. William age 26 is a potter and Maria 23 is a dressmaker. Williams father John Hodgson is a potter and Maria's father Thomas Bull is a Mariner. They marry in the presence of John and Catherine Radford

William Hodgson (father)

William Hodgson was baptised at St James, Bristol on 11th Feb 1827. Parents John Bartlett (potter) and Ann.

1841 census: William Hodgson listed as age 14, living with his parents John 45 (potter), and Ann 37. Siblings: John 13, Ann 11, Joseph 10, Eliza 7, Louisa 2. Address is Temple Back, Bristol.

1851 census: William Hodgson listed as age 25 (potter) pressing with parents John 53 (potter pressing), Ann 45. Siblings: Mary Ann 22, Joseph 21 (potter pressing), Eliza 18 (domestic duties), Louisa 12 (sch), George 9 (sch), George Lewis 25 (visitor, Seaman). Address is 8 Engineering Rd, Temple Back, Bristol.

1861 census William Hodgson listed as age 33 (potter), Maria (mother) 27, sister Maria 4. At the baptism of daughters baby Elizabeth and Maria (age 4) 24th Nov 1861 at Temple, Bristol William was potter.

1871 census William Hodgson listed as age 44 (Bird Fanger?) Maria 37, Elizabeth 9, William 8, Thomas 6, John 5, Henry 3, Frederick 1, Alice Hopkin 14 (general servant). Address - 7 Temple St, Bristol.

In 1871 William Hodgson's reading and writing was recorded as"imp" as he was found guilty of receiving stolen goods at Long Aston and sentenced to 6 months hard labour. He served from 13th Dec to 3rd July 1871 at Shepton Mallet County Gaol. He was accused of receiving 14 pheasants knowing them to be stolen.

1881 census William Hodgson listed as age 54 (bird dealer), Maria 47, *ELIZABETH HODGSON* 19 (Telegraphist Civil Service), William 17 (Postman), Thomas 15 (Stable boy), John 14 (scholar), Henry 12 (scholar), Frederick 10 (scholar), Kate 8 (scholar). Address is 7 Temple St, Bristol.

1891 census - William Hodgson age 62 (potter), Maria 57, Henry 24 (tailor), Kate 18 (dressmaker).

1901 census- William Hodgson age 73 (no occupation), Maria 63, (own account at home, dressmaker), Kate 29 (dressmaker own account at home).

Elizabeth Hodgson had one sister Maria who was 4 years older but they were baptised together after Elizabeth was born.

Elizabeth had 5 younger brothers and one younger sister.

1891 census - Elizabeth Hodgson aged 29 is listed at Boston House, Melrose Road, Bedminster as Telegraphist. Neighbours on both sides are post office employees: 1) James Wright aged 19 (Telegraphist) is living one side at Melrose House 2) Frederick W Andrews aged 26 (Post Office Clerk).

1901 census - At the time of the census 1901 in Bristol Elizabeth Hodgson was resident at the Asylum having been admitted 21st January 1901. I have not found this census.

Elizabeth Hodgson entered Bristol Asylum on 23 Jan 1901. I have not found records of the census record 1901 for the Bristol Asylum.

Elizabeth Hodgson died at Bristol Lunatic Asylum, Aberdeen Road, Bristol on 11 Nov 1901. Cause of death was Chronic Brights. Her brother Henry Hodgson was the informant of death.

At time of death, brother Henry was resident at 19 Trinity St, Bristol. He was aged 33.
