Discrepancy in birth dates. Two Robert Brysons born both to fathers named Robert and both weavers: one in 1802, and another in 1804. The Fife burial index for Robert Bryson d 13 March Bookseller suggests he was born in 1789 but I haven't been able to find that on Scotland's People or anywhere else. But the one that seems most likely is the Robert born 20th May 1804 and baptised Nov 1804.<sup>ii</sup>

- 1825: Marriage to Helen Kennedy 17 Oct. Robert listed as "Bookbinder of this parish Son of Robert Bryson Weaver in Cupar". Helen listed as "of this Parish, Daughter of William Kennedy Ship's Carpenter".iv
- 1834, 1835 directory: Robert Bryson, Bookbinder and Stationer, 189 High Street Kirkcaldy. See also reference to Fife Herald being made available to buy because of increased demand at Robert Bryson Bookseller. Advert for apprentice boy for grocer in Fife Herald 1840, apply to Robert Bryson bookseller.
- 1841: Court case regarding passing of counterfeit shillings. Mentions Robert Bryson. viii
- 1841 Census: No information to be found on any site. Suggestion that the 1841 census info for much of Fife was lost in the Firth of Forth as it was being transported across.
- Died: 13 March 1848<sup>ix</sup>
- Buried: b 16 March 1848. Bookseller aged 45. Son-in-law of William Kennedy and Janet Henderson. A newspaper death notice mentions his "lingering illness" of 8 months duration. Another refers to him as a "bookseller and councillor". Wife Helen the sole beneficiary of his will. Bequeathed £121 Os 2d. Will written month prior to death.
